Traditional Painting Methods

THE PROBLEM

The negative consequences of traditional painting methods clearly make the case for going green whenever you are choosing a painting contractor.

Poor Indoor Air Quality

- The EPA has identified poor indoor air quality as one of the five leading health risks in the United States.
- People spend 80% to 90% of their time indoors. Maintaining a high indoor air quality is imperative to the health of your employees.
- According to the EPA, 9% of the airborne pollutants creating ground level ozone come from the volatile organic compounds (VOC's) in paint.

Exposure To Toxins

- The “clean” smell of conventional paint is actually vapors being released from toxic solvents while the coating dries. Known as VOC's, these gases can harm human lungs and are possible carcinogens.
- EPA estimates that indoor levels of VOC's were 1000 times higher than outdoor levels after painting.
- Exposure to VOC's can result in side affects such as skin, eye and respiratory irritation, headache, dizziness and nausea. Other studies show exposure to paint fumes can also increase the risk of asthma and pregnancy miscarriage.

Harm To Our Planet

- The disposal of conventional paints causes landfill and groundwater contamination whereas zero VOC paints are not considered hazardous waste materials.
- It takes roughly two gallons of water to clean one paintbrush and five gallons to clean a roller cover. There are now ways to treat wastewater for proper disposal which protects our waterways.
